Plessy v. Ferguson (1896)

“separate but equal” In 1954, the Court rejected this doctrine in a case called Brown v Board of Education of Topeka, in which parents fought against “separate but equal” schools (However, that case only applied to schools—not trains, buses, or other facilities) How did the Court’s reasoning change?
